



2024 DEFENSIBLE SPACE & COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP

The Town, in partnership with Mammoth Disposal, Mammoth Lakes Chamber of Commerce and Mammoth Mountain Ski Area, has scheduled a Defensible Space and Community Clean-Up event on May 17 & 18. **Town staff/volunteers will NOT be collecting yard waste or household trash from properties.**

- **Mammoth Disposal Office:** May 1-17, Mon-Fri, 8am-4pm (59 Commerce Drive)
- **Community Recreation Center:** May 18, 9am-12pm (686 Old Mammoth Road)

DEFENSIBLE SPACE CLEAN-UP EVENT

Dates: Friday, May 17 & Saturday, May 18

Time: 8:00am – 3:30pm daily

All Green Waste & Trash Drop-off: 299 Commerce Drive (Town Yard) NOT at the Mammoth Disposal Transfer Station

Bring your green waste to the Town Yard for chipping or to place in the green waste bin. Defensible space is the buffer between your property and the grass, trees, shrubs, or any wildland area that surrounds your home. This 100-foot space from your home or to your property line (whichever is closer) is needed to slow or stop the spread of wildfire and to protect your home from catching fire. You can promote a healthy defensible space zone by removing ground litter and trimming up trees to 15 feet (not to exceed one-third of the tree).

What you CAN drop off:

- **For MLFD chipper:** clean branches and tree limbs less than 12" in diameter and greater than 18" in length only.
- **For Town Yard bins:** Pine cones/needles, grass clippings, leaf debris, root balls, construction lumber, fence posts, pallets, dog waste and community trash; large bulky items (furniture, appliances, mattresses); metal objects (refrigerators, snow stakes, motorized equipment – no vehicles, all fluids must be removed); recyclable materials, food waste, and e-waste (TV's and electronics).
- **For Mammoth Disposal Transfer Station:** Household Hazardous Waste (HHW): paint (max. 5 gallons/day), antifreeze, oil, paint, etc.

What you CANNOT drop off:

- No tires or railroad ties with oil will be accepted.



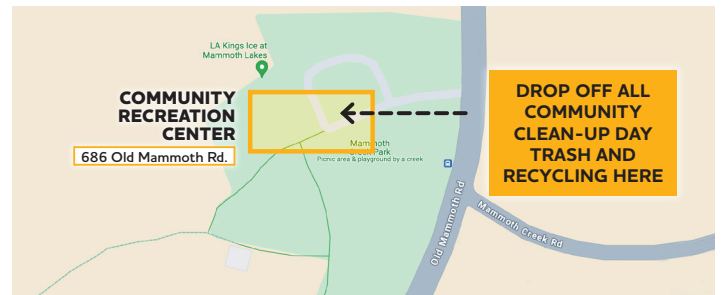
COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP EVENT
